Amy Hopwood is a folk singer/songwriter based in Exeter, Devon. She sings traditional folk and writes her own thought-provoking songs, accompanying herself on tenor guitar.

Tobias Raven accompanies Amy at festivals, playing guitar, bass and whistle. Together they deliver a mix of traditional and original folk, with plenty of humour and a bit of an edge. There'll be fun songs to join in with, pretty ones to send you a bit misty eyed and others with lyrics interesting enough to get your teeth into!



In the last few years (with obvious gaps for Covid!) they have played at a number of festivals along the South West coast, including Cornwall Folk Festival, Dorset Seafood Festival, Wessex Folk Festival, Bridport Folk Festival and Sturminster Newton Literary Festival.

Amy's music has been played a number of times on BBC 6 Music and is regularly played on a range of folk radio shows, including Readifolk, Forest Folk, Acoustic Café, Acoustic Routes and Folk and Roots.
